As you are aware the University Grants Commission—is continuously monitoring the Prevention of Caste based discrimination in Higher Educational Institutions. Further, the University Grants Commission has issued letters dated 19.07.2011, 02.07.2013 and also D.O. letter dated 01.03.2016 and 05.9.2016 to request you to take the following action:

- I. The Officials/faculty members should desist from any act of discrimination against SC/ST students on grounds of their social origin.
- The University/Institute/College may develop a page on their website for lodging such complaints of caste discrimination by SC/ST students and also place a complaint register in the Registrar/Principal office for the purpose. If any such incident comes to the notice of the authorities, action should be taken against the erring official/faculty members promptly.
- III. The university and colleges should ensure that no official/faculty members indulge in any kind of discrimination against any community or category of students.
- iv. The University may constitute a Committee to look into the discriminating complaints received from the SCs/STs students/Teachers and non-teaching staff.

You are also requested to advise the officials/faculty members of your university/institute that they should be more sensitive while dealing with above such incidents of caste discrimination, and send Action Taken Report to UGC within 30 days in the prescribed format (copy enclosed) and also on the email: sctsection@gmail.com.

The above instructions may also be circulated to all the constituent and affiliated colleges of your university for follow-up action please.

Dear Sir Madam.

This has reference to Ministry of Chemicals & Fertilizers and Parliamentary Affairs, Golletter No.5587/M(C&F)/17 dated 11th March 2017 regarding the recent decision of the Government to regulate the prices of coronary stents is a very important milestone in regulation of prices of drugs and medical devices, which is aimed to substantially reduce the burden on the pockets of the poor patient; and then kin.

There is a very high incidence of Coronary Artery Disease (CAD) in India associated with high morbidity and mortality and coronary stent implantation is an important treatment. The Central Government has therefore, included the same in the selectule 1 of the Drugs (Price Control) Order, 2013 on 21/12/2016, enabling National Pharmaceuticals Pricing Authority (NPPA) to regulate the prices of coronary stents and monitor their availability. NPPA, after detailed stakeholder consultations, notified the ceiling prices of the coronary stents on 13/02/2017 under two categories.

1. Bare Metal Stents

Rs. 7260/-

 Drug Eluting metallic DES and including Stents (DES) and Bio-resorbable Vascular Scaffold (BVs)/Biodegradable Stents Rs. 29.600 -
